We will work with Jim Borowski on any details. We need one new large HERE sign as well as our existing one. It would be good to have a sign at our old location telling where we moved to if the Town would approve. We can ask to be put on the electric sign at Community Park. We will meet at Christus to decide on the layout. We hope Roni can handle the advertising, flyers saying we moved, fix Post Crescent, Website. Leanne will update the policies, application and send to vendors. Lisa will work on a Kids Expo for the 3rd Wednesday of June. We can ask the Fire Department to show up for the first market, May 29.

PLASTIC BAGS RECYCLE – Possible new project through the Trex program. We could recycle bags and earn a bench. How many pounds do we need to collect before we can send in? How and where do we send it?

ELECTRONIC RECYCLE – Try to get a July Wednesday date. John will contact the recycle company and Christus.

RAIN BARRELS – John and Lisa are working with the school's art teachers. John dropped off a barrel for them. John will try to buy about 25 more barrels for us to turn into Rain Barrels.

EARTH DAY 2019 – Roni is working on a speaker regarding invasive species. Leanne will put in the Town Newsletter that we will deliver free mulch to Greenville residents again on Saturday April 27th.
